SARA VAN ROMPAEY - E²ARC (Energy Efficient Architecture Renovation Conservation)

Sara Van Rompaey studied **Architecture** in Ghent (Belgium) and **Monument Conservation** at the RLICC (Raymond Lemaire International Centre for Conservation) at the KULeuven University.

As an independent Architect she has more than 25 years of expertise in the design, development and execution of buildings projects with a special focus on **energy efficient renovation and conservation**. The portfolio contains restoration projects of protected monuments, energy efficient renovations of historic buildings, renovations & extensions of rural buildings, mansions and villas, new construction of apartments, family houses and interior design projects. At district-level several Masterplans with an historical, urban and architectural analysis were designed.

Since 2011 she is regularly invited by the European Commission as an **Expert and Reviewer of EU Research projects** in the field of the refurbishment of existing (historic) buildings towards Nearly Zero-Energy Buildings and districts. She is also involved in several EU projects as an expert.
